However, the defense was smoking! The outfield of Manager Dan, Scott, and Steve combined for 6 catches, a large percentage on really hard shots. Dan even made a diving catch in left field and turned a line drive base hit into a force out at second base.

John led the infield defense by sucking up about everything that came his way at short center, as he posted 3 putouts and 5 assists.

That stifling defense was enough to vault the **Legends** to a 4-2 win over *SOKOL*.

Although the good guys only managed 12 hits tonight, 11 of which were singles, they made the most of them.

All four runs were scored on clutch two out singles.

In the second inning, when Joe ripped a double with one out, it turned out to be the only extra base hit the **Legends** would muster. However, John followed it with a long fly out that sent Joe to third base. It allowed Lynn's ensuing base hit to right field to give the **Legends** a 1-0 lead.

In the fourth inning, *SOKOL* loaded the bases with one out. They then tied the game at one apiece on a sacrifice fly to Scott, but that was all they would get.

The good guys grabbed the lead back in the next inning when Jerry singled with one out. He moved to second base on Ken's infield out, and scored on Tom's two out single to right field.

In the bottom of the fifth, *SOKOL* tied the game again at 2-2.

However, the **Legends** retook the lead in the top of the sixth inning. It started with one out when Manager Dan and Tim banged out back to back base hits. Joe then hit one back to the pitcher, the sixth inning when their first two hitters led off with singles. However, John stepped up by fielding a ground ball, stepping on second, and throwing a strike to Jerry at first for a 10-3 double play. He then put the cherry on top by also throwing out the next batter at first base.

In the bottom of the seventh inning, *SOKOL* got a two out single, but the next batter popped out to Joe at short-stop to end the game.

It is the seventh consecutive victory over *SOKOL* by our men in pistachio.

The whole left side of the **Legends** infield tonight was nearly flawless. Besides John, Joe posted a putout and two assists at short, while Tom posted three putouts at third base.

Tonight's offensive kudos got to Tom, Joe, and John with two hits apiece, and John was credited with the game winning RBI on his two run single in the sixth inning.

Legends give up 4 run seventh inning, lose heartbreaker, 8-7

June 8 - After losing twice to *Fat Sax* last year, it looked like the boys were going to get some revenge tonight.

The **Legends** led 7-4 going into the top of the seventh inning, but *Fat Sax* rallied for four runs and beat our boys again, 8-7. The loss drops our season record to 1-2.

The good guys jumped on top 1-0 in the bottom of the first inning. With one out, Steve singled and moved to second base when Joe walked. Scott forced Joe at second base, but on a wild throw to first base, Steve came around to score.

Sax took a 2-1 lead in the top of the second inning, but in the bottom of the inning, Manager Dan led off with a home run bomb to left field to tie the score at 2 apiece. It was his first four bagger of the season and the 34th of his career, tying him with his dad!

It was still tied in the bottom of the third inning when Steve again singled after one out. He moved to second base as Joe grounded out to the second baseman. Then three straight singles scored two runs. First it was Scott with an RBI base hit.
