## 2 MORE EXTENDS LOSING STREAK TO 5; BUT DAN K, TOM AND SCOTT EACH BANG OUT 5 MORE HITS

June 21 - SOKOL scored in every inning tonight to beat the men in green, 14-8. It broke the streak of 8 straight games that the **Legends** had beaten SOKOL.

The good guys trailed 2-0 when they came to bat in the bottom of the first inning. That's when Dan K, the **Legends'** leading hitter, led off with a base hit. He then moved to second base on Ed's infield out.

Next, Steve got a base hit to put runners on the corners. Tom then banged out an RBI single. Joe followed with a shot back to the pitcher. The pitcher forced Tom out at second, but the relay to first was wide, allowing Steve to cross the plate with the tying run.

Scott then cleared the bases with an RBI triple, and he crossed the plate on Phil's ensuing base hit. The **Legends** were then up 4-2.

In the third inning, our boys now trailed 8-4, but not for long. With one out, Tom singled again, and Joe hit a bomb to left field for a triple to score Tom. Scott then beat out and infield hit, allowing Joe to score from third, and it closed the gap to 8-6.

Unfortunately over the next three innings, the **Legends** could not manufacture more than one hit per inning. So the boys trailed 14-6 going into the bottom of the seventh.

Dan K opened that inning with a missile over the left fielder's head for a four bagger, his first of the season. Dan S and Steve followed with back to back singles, giving the fans a taste of a possible rally.

After that, Tom hit into a fielder's choice, and Joe followed with an RBI single. Unfortunately, Scott then hit into a fielder's choice, and Phil struck out to end the game.

Dan K and Joe led the offense tonight with 3 hits and 2 runs scored apiece. Joe also had 3 RBI'S.

On the defensive side, Manager Lynn was a one man show in the infield, posting 5 PO's and 2 A's

#### at short center.

In the outfield...who else? Dan had 3 catches in left field, while Scott grabbed two and posted an assist in the second inning.

June 28 - In four of the Legends previous six losses this season, the good guys have given up one inning of seven or more runs in each of them. Tonight, it became five out of seven.

The men in green trailed 6-4 going into the bottom of the sixth inning, and BANG! They got hit with an 8 run inning. Game over. Final score; *4 Baggers* 14, **Legends** 4.

In the top of the first inning, however, our boys took a 1-0 lead when Dan K led off with a walk (a WHAT?).

Ed followed with a base hit, which sent Dan to third. Steve then forced Ed at second which allowed Dan to score.

Next up, Tom singled Steve to second base, and then Joe lined into a double play to end the threat and the inning.

So the **Legends** trailed 4-1 going into the top of the fourth inning, but they rallied to tie the

#### game.

Ed started things with a lead off walk. After Steve forced him at second base, Tom also took ball four, setting the table for the middle of the **Legends** order.

Joe came through, ripping a triple to clear the bases. Then Scott doubled Joe home, but was tossed out at third. Tim was next and banged out a double, but was left stranded at second. The score was now tied, 4-4.

*Baggers* took a 6-4 lead in the bottom of the 5th inning, but it was their 8 run splurge in the bottom of the sixth inning that ended the game.

Tom and Scott led the offense tonight, both going 3 for 3. Joe drove in 2 runs, and four different **Legends** tallied a run.

Defensively, in the outfield...all together now...it was Dan in left field with 2 catches and an assist.

In the infield, Tom posted 3 putouts and 3 assists at third base. Joe had a putout and 4 assists from shortstop, while Tim posted his second straight 5 putout game at first base. Ken even pitched in from the mound by striking out three guys!
