Little Guys use small ball to take down Legends, 16-5

July 23 game one - Six weeks ago Little Guys beat the Legends 20-9 in 5 innings. Tonight was round two, but basically with the same result. The good guys lost again by 11 runs and in five innings, 16-5.

Most of the big teams in this league roster some big boys who hit long balls. *Little Guys* had only one big dude, and that was their third baseman. I suspect that's how their name was derived.

Although they didn't hit long balls, they did nothing, but rip line drives everywhere; both foul lines, in the alleys, between infielders, at infielders,...basically everywhere.

In the bottom of the second inning, the **Legends** got on the board. Scott led off with a base hit, and went around to third base when JoeB followed with his third double of the season. It looked like the start of a big inning.

Manager Dan then hit a long fly ball to left, and after the catch, Scott tagged up to score, and JoeB advanced to third.

Ed followed by grounding out to the infield for the second out, but it did score Joe. Then Matt doubled for his first **Leg-ends** extra base hit, but got

stranded as Jerry grounded into the third out.

In the top of the third, *Little Guys* expanded their lead to 11-2, but it could have been a lot more had it not been for Scott making a great running catch in center field.

In the bottom of the third inning, Alex led things off with, what else, a walk. He moved to second base when Swyn singled.

Tom then walked to load the bases with nobody out.

That brought Tim to the plate. He drove in a run when he grounded out to the third baseman. JoeV was next.

Joe grounded back to the pitcher for out number two.

However, Scott then stepped up and drilled a 3 run four bagger to left center to draw the **Men** in **Black** to within, 11-6. It was Scott's 3rd homer of the season and 19th of his **Legends** career.

Unfortunately, that was

all the scoring for the good guys. Tom led the offense tonight going 3 for 3, while Scott, Alex, and Swyn each went 2 for 2.

Defensively, Manager Dan led the outfield with 5 catches. JoeB and JoeV led the infield at short and short center.
