Ed lined a base hit to left and the left fielder made a diving effort to catch it, but missed. It then became a footrace. Ed slid into third base under the tag for an RBI triple!

Sadly, in the bottom of the third inning, *Nancy's* scored 9 runs to open an 11-2 lead and never looked back. What opened the door that inning was a couple infield errors.

...while Manager Dan's relief staff, Tim, had his raised to 38.50.



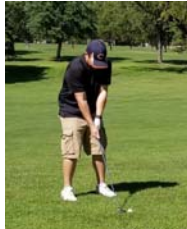
...and that's centerfielder Steve disappearing into the distance, chasing after a ball hit in the alley.

Scott's 3 run blast and the Legends defense lead to a 12-5 win

August 22 - After playing only one game over a six week span earlier this season, the **Legends** are now in the midst of a season ending stretch of 4 games in 6 days. Go figure!

Tonight, the **Legends** put it all together both on offense and defense. Offensively, 11 players joined the hit parade, while the entire defense was as tough as nails.

Our men in black jumped out to a 7-0 lead before *PFYM* even came to bat. Tom and Tim led things off with back to back walks.

Then Scott crushed a 3-1 pitch for a four bagger, putting the good guys up 3 zip. It was his fourth home run of the season and 20th of his **Legends** career. However, the boys were not even close to being done.

JoeB then took ball four, and came around to score on Manager Dan's ensuing triple. Not to be outdone, Matt followed with a triple of his own, making the score 5-0.

JoeV then struck out for the first out, but his brother, Ed, picked up the ball by banging out an RBI single.

Alex moved Ed to second base on an infield out, and Jerry singled him home to make the score 7-0.

PFYM pushed a run across in the bottom of the inning, but the **Legends** were able to shut the door on them mainly because of Tom at third and Matt at short center. They each threw a runner out at first base on two hard hit smashes.

However, if we're going to talk defense, Alex in the bottom of the second inning made the play of the game and maybe the season. He came running in from deep center field on a looping ball, and the infield came running out for it. At the very last moment, Alex went down, caught the ball, rolled over and held on to it for the out!

In the bottom of the third inning, Scott joined in the defensive fun when he threw a batter out at second base trying

to stretch a single into a double with Matt applying the tag. That play held *PFYM* to only one run in the inning.

Now leading 7-2 in the top of the fourth inning, the **Legends** bats came alive once again.

With one out, Tom got a base hit and Tim walked again. Then Scott and JoeB each banged out back to back RBI singles.

After that, Manager Dan cleared the bases with a double, and the **Legends** now led 11-2.

In the bottom of the fourth inning, JoeB also joined the highlight reel with a great running catch of a looping ball near the foul line in short left field.

In the sixth inning, the men of story and song added another run when Tom led off with a single to right field, and two outs later he crossed the plate on JoeB's two base hit.

In the bottom of the sixth inning, *PFYM* scored 3 runs until JoeB and Matt slammed the door shut. Joe snagged a line drive and flipped the ball to Matt at second to double the runner off the base. That 6-10 double play ended the inning and pretty much *PFYM*'S chances of catching the **Legends** the rest of the way as our boys shut them out in the 7th inning to post a 12-5 win.

Tonight's offense was led by Tom's 4 for 4 and 3 runs scored. Scott posted 4 RBI's and was credited with the game winning RBI.

Defensively, the outfield was led by Manager Dan's 5 catches in left field. In the infield, everyone gets a thumbs up

led by Matt and JoeB posting 3 putouts and 2 assists apiece. JoeV had 3 assists at second base, and Tim added 7 more putouts at first base.

Then in the same inning, with one out he ran for Jerry on first base. When Steve hit the ball, Duke instantly lit out for second base. Unfortunately Steve popped out to the **third baseman**, and Duke was easily doubled off first base.

Having heard Duke say it for decades, the elder **Legends** knew what was coming...
